

What is a SPMRSM IGCSE?

SPMRSM IGCSE or formerly known as the Dual Certification Programme is an MRSM education system that offers two certifications, IGCSE and SPM, in a five-year school programme. Learners study both the Malaysian national curriculum (KBSM) and the Cambridge International curriculum. This integration gives an added value to learners' learning experience. Students will take the Cambridge IGCSE at the end of Form 4 and the SPM at the end of Form 5. Learners are highly encouraged to learn and go beyond SPM.



About Cambridge IGCSE

- **Globally recognised.**

Cambridge IGCSE is accepted by leading universities and employers worldwide as evidence of academic ability, providing an international passport to progression and success. In the UK, Cambridge IGCSE is accepted as equivalent to GCSE.

- **Flexible.** Cambridge IGCSE is available in 70 subjects, including over 30 languages, in any combination. Core and extended curricula are available in many subjects for students of differing abilities. Schools are free to develop a curriculum that suits their learners' needs.

- **Learner-centred.** Syllabuses use learner-centred and enquiry-based approaches to learning. Cambridge IGCSE develops skills in creative thinking, enquiry and problem solving.

- **Rigorous assessment.** Learners are assessed at the end of the course. This linear structure gives more uninterrupted teaching time. Learners are awarded a grade from A* to G for each subject, with A* being the highest grade.

- **International outlook.** Cambridge IGCSE has been designed with two concepts in mind: international standards and contextualised learning. The content suits a wide variety of schools and avoids cultural bias.

- **Tried and tested.** 2013 marked the 25th anniversary of the first Cambridge IGCSE exam.

MRSM students are above average students, thus they need a challenging and differentiated curriculum.

The programmes and qualifications set the global standard for international education. They are created by subject experts, rooted in academic rigour and reflect the latest educational research.

There is an 80 - 85% overlap of the Sciences and Mathematics curriculum for SPM and IGCSE.

The IGCSE approach focuses on building oral and practical skills.

They provide a strong platform for learners to progress from one stage to the next, and are well supported by teaching and learning resources.
